

The Eastmoor Pool is home to the Swordfish Swim Team which has over 120 kids from ages 4 years old to 18 years old. It is one of the last community-owned pools in the City of Columbus and maintains operations solely through the generosity of the membership and business sponsors. Memberships for the 2025 season range from Family: \$440; Couple: \$275; Individual: \$200; Senior Couple: \$205; Senior Individual: \$100. commercial corridors. Our traffic islands are actually City of Columbus park land - the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department mows the grass and maintains the trees, while most other maintenance is coordinated by the civic association. We are grateful to a number of neighbors who have stepped up to serve as TILE's (Traffic Island Leaders of Eastmoor) who assist with spring cleanup and mulching around the trees on the islands.

In addition, all of our traffic islands (except Virginialee Circle) undergo a series of turf treatments during the growing season to help strengthen the grass and choke out weeds. Our dedicated volunteers and your ECA Membership dues help keep Eastmoor looking great - thank you!
